Please note if the advert supplied is the incorrect size, we will ask you to re-supply it.

Supply your adverts as a high resolution (300DPI) PDF file

We will accept .jpg, .tif or .psd files if your company does not have software to be able to PDF.

.JPG files - these should be flattened files.

.TIF files - these should also be flattened files with no layers included.

.PSD files - any Photoshop files supplied must have font layers rasterized or have font files sent with the psd.

How to supply advert elements

Send all text that you want on your advert in a word document. Send all images in a zipped (compressed) folder. Please make sure your images and/or logos are hi-res (300DPI) and preferably .tif, .jpg or .eps. We will need your highest quality company logo too (best sent as an .eps, however a large .jpg or .tif will be accepted).

Any .eps files should have fonts outlined prior to sending to us.

Ensuring we have correct company colours & fonts

We would appreciate any brand guidelines you may have, as this will give us the information needed to keep within your company branding. If no guidelines are available, please let us know your company colours as a pantone or 4 colour (cmyk) breakdown. Let us know of the normal fonts you use too - if you have a premium font that you use for advert promotions, please send us the font files.

Sending us adverts or advert assets

Emailing us with PDF's and/or assets

Ensure all assets (images, logos, text, etc) you send for your advert are all in one email. Clearly state the company name, advert size and magazine issue the advert is for in the email subject line - this clears up any confusion.


